He also serves as the Fellowship Training Program Director and is the Interim Division Chief of the Division of Pediatric Hematology/Oncology. He has a long standing research interest in histiocytic disorders, with HLH and Langerhans Cell Histiocytosis (LCH) being the most common. He has specialized in the diagnosis and care of HLH patients, and has conducted clinical research of HLH patients. He is an active member of the Histiocytosis Society, and is involved in the activities of Hike-for-a-Cure and Histiocure Foundations, two Bay Area patient support networks.


